Illinois Council of Community College Administrators Conference

Theme: *Thriving Through Change: A Resilient Framework for Illinois*

The Illinois Council of Community College Administrators (ICCCA) invites dynamic and thought-provoking proposals for its upcoming annual conference, taking place November 18-20, 2026, at the Embassy Suites by Hilton East Peoria Riverfront Hotel and Conference Center, located at 100 Conference Center Drive, East Peoria, IL 61611.

This year's theme, "**Thriving Through Change: A Resilient Framework for Illinois,**" highlights the critical role community colleges play in navigating uncertainty, adapting to evolving needs, and strengthening the communities we serve. Across Illinois, community colleges are innovating in response to demographic shifts, economic pressures, technological advancements, and changing student expectations.

We seek proposals that showcase **exceptional programs, initiatives, partnerships, and learning opportunities** that demonstrate resilience, creativity, and measurable impact. Proposals should offer attendees relatable, real-world examples of how your services or products can be practically applied within community college settings, while clearly supporting the conference theme.

Each session is scheduled for 50 minutes, with a 10-minute intermission. ICCCA will provide carts, screens, and projection systems; however, presenters are kindly asked to bring their own laptops.

Please note that the deadline for proposal submissions is **July 16, 2026**. Notifications of acceptance will be communicated by **August 8, 2026**.  - Leadership development and institutional culture initiatives
 - Data-informed decision-making
- **Teaching, Learning & Innovation**
 - High-impact teaching practices
 - Technology-enhanced learning and AI integration
 - Scalable instructional or student support models
- **Sustainability & Future Readiness**
 - Financial sustainability and resource optimization
 - Strategic planning for long-term institutional health
